

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the payment of a sum of money to Henry Aisquith, for professional services rendered the State,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 57, of the Code of Public Local Laws for Prince George's County, as enacted by the Act of 1876, Chapter 105, entitled an Act to repeal Section 44, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled Prince George's County, under the title of "Collectors" enacted by the Act of 1872, Chapter 294, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add additional sections thereto,

Was read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follows :

Senate bill entitled an Act to enable the qualified voters of the 2d, 3d, 5th and 6th Election Districts, of Queen Anne's County, to determine by ballot whether spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold in any of said districts, or a license granted for the sale of the same,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
