Senate bill entitled an Act to prohibit the taking and catching of oysters for sale in certain waters in Calvert County.

Senate Joint Resolutions in relation to the bill now pending before Congress, granting pensions to the survivors of the soldiers, sailors and marines, who served in the war with Mexico,

Were read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the Act of 1853, Chapter 137, entitled an Act to incorporate the Patapsco Company, by repealing Sections 5 and 11 of said Act, and re-enacting said sections with amendments,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
