mine by ballot whether spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold in said districts, or a license granted for a sale of the same therein,

Being upon its second reading,

Mr. Sulivane moved a call of the Senate.

The Sergeant-at-Arms was directed to inform absent Senators that their presence was required in the Senate Chamber.

On motion by Mr. McLane,

The further proceedings under the call were dispensed with.

Mr. Bannon submitted the following amendment:
