House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to the Code of Public Local Laws, Article 4, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Bridges and Highways," to follow after section thereof numbered 137, to be called sub-Section A.

Mr. McLane, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Harford County to locate and establish a public landing on the east side of Bush River, at or near a point called the "Sod."

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Wilson, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to enable the County Commissioners of Calvert County to ascertain the financial condition of said county, and to make provision for the payment of debts due by said county.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Franklin, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Sections 9 and 10, of Chapter 424, of the Acts of 1868, entitled an Act to incorporate the Town of Berlin, in Worcester County, and to reenact the same with amendments.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Lancaster submitted the following message:
