Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

House bill entitled an Act to execute the powers conferred upon the General Assembly of this State by Section 39, of Article 4, of the Constitution of this State, by providing by law another Court for the City of Baltimore, to be known as the Second Criminal Court of Baltimore, and by prescribing its jurisdiction and powers.
