House bill entitled an Act to repeal the 89th Section of the 16th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Chancery," and relating to non-resident infant defendants, as amended by the Act of 1868, Chapter 200, and to insert in said Article, in lieu of the section so repealed, the following section, to process against non-resident infant defendants.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.
