hibiting the issue of notes or obligations in place of money or loans, to be called sub-Section A,

With the following amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

1st. Insert after the word "kind," in 6th line of sub-Section A, the words "in lieu of money of said Company or Association borrowing therefrom."

2nd. In same section, line 7, strike out the word "thereof or borrowed therefrom in lieu of money."

3rd. In line 8, of same section, after the word "Association," strike out the words "to or for the use or benefit of any member or borrower in lieu of money," and insert the words "contrary to the provisions of this section."

Which were adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time.

Also, favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments the 8th Section of the 38th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers."

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the issuing of policies of life insurance in this State, for the benefit of the wife, children, dependent relative or creditor, upon the life of any person in the State,

With the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend the first section by inserting before the word "person" in the last line, the word "insured."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time.

House bill entitled an Act amendatory of Section 10, of an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance-Company of Somerset and Worcester Counties, passed March 13th, 1867, Chapter 147, of January Session, 1867.
