"Section 6, And be it enacted, That any party or parties against whom any Justice of the Peace shall have rendered a judgment under the provisions of this Act, may at any time within twenty days from the rendition thereof, appeal from such judgment to the Circuit Court, for the county in which said judgment may be rendered."

Section 6, heretofore adopted, to be "Section 7."
