this Act, any person or persons so convicted shall be fined not less than ten dollars, or more than twenty-five dollars, at the discretion of the Justice, and stand committed by said Justice until the fine and costs are paid.

Which was adopted, and,

Said bill was then read the second time.

Senate bill entitled an Act to regulate the compensation of the Sheriff of Prince George's County for keeping and boarding prisoners in Jail.

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Talbot County to appoint an additional Constable for the First Election District of said county.

Was read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays as follows:
