AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In Section 6, line 1, Chapter 19, strike out all the words from the beginning of the section down to and including the word "March," in line 2, and insert in lieu thereof the following : "on the first day of October, one-fourth, on the first day of January, one fourth, and one-fourth on the fif-day of March, and all the balance collected on the fifteenth day of June.
