House bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 1, of Chapter 291, of the Acts passed at January Session, of 1876, entitled an Act to remove all gates from the public roads of Charles County.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Baltimore County to provide station houses or lock-ups in portions of the county adjacent to the City of Baltimore.
