House bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 5, of an Act entitled an Act to exempt all that portion of the waters of the Chesapeake Bay, therein described, from the effect and operations of Sections 1 and 3, of Article 98, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Wild Fowl," passed at the January Session, 1872, Chapter 54, and to re-enact the same with amendments; and also to repeal Section 21, of the same Article, as repealed and re-enacted by Act passed at January Session, 1876, Chapter 169, and to re-enact the same, also with amendment.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries.
