Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to give additional corporate powers to the House of the Good Shepherd of the City of Baltimore, and to provide for the commitments thereto of dissolute and disorderly females, for the purpose of reformation,

With the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

At end of Section 8 add:

"And the sum of two thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to pay the said twenty cents per day, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time.

Also, unfavorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for taking the vote of the people of Charles County on the question of changing the county seat of said county, and removing the Court-House from Port Tobacco to La Plata, and to provide for the purchase of a site at La Plata, and the building of a Court-House thereon.

Pending the consideration of the unfavorable report,

Mr. Lancaster moved to substitute the bill for the unfavorable report,

Which motion was rejected by yeas and nays as follows:
