House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Protestant Infant Asylum, of Baltimore City, to bind out and control the destitute children under its care.

With the following amendment:

## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In line 24, Section 1, after the word "out," insert "in this State," and strike out from the word "and" inclusive in line 25, down to the word "provided," in line 29.

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time.
