House bill entitled an Act to repeal Sections 49 and 50, of Article 18, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "Leonardtwn," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to enable the qualified voters of Kent County to determine by ballot whether spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold in said county, or in any election district thereof, or a license granted for the sale of the same.
