

House bill entitled an Act to refund at a lower rate of interest part of the debt of Washington County, and to empower the County Commissioners of Washington County to call in the bonds of said county, issued pursuant to an Act of Assembly, passed at the January Session, 1866, Chapter 19, and an Act passed at the January Session, 1874, Chapter 145,

Was read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays as follows:
