Public General Laws, title "Wild Fowl," passed at January Session, 1872, Chapter 54, and to re-enact the same with amendments; and also to repeal Section 21, of the same Article, as repealed and re-enacted by Act passed at January Session, 1876, Chapter 169, and to re-enact the same also with amendment.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal Sections 1 and 2, of the Acts of January Session 1872, Chapter 198, entitled an Act for the protection of, and to regulate the time and manner of catching and taking fish and terrapins in that portion of the Potomac river between Maryland Point, in Charles County, and Chisildines Island, in St. Mary's County, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add additional sections thereto.

Which were read the second time.

Mr. Dennis, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to protect fish in the waters of Somerset County.

Which was read the second time.

Also, favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Somerset County to have a bridge built across the Annamessex river.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Steiner, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to lay out and establish a new election district in Frederick County, out of portions of Frederick District, No. 2, and Creagerstown District, No. 4, to be called Lewistown District, or Election District No. 20.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Bannon, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 194, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Sheriff."

With the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Amend Section 1, line 8, by striking out the words "another section in lieu," and insert "the same with amendments."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time.
