Senate bill entitled an Act to amend Section 3, of Chapter 367, of the Acts of 1874, entitled an Act to enable the Commissioners of Somerset County to provide a fund for the redemption of outstanding county bonds, by repealing said Section 3, and re-enacting the same with amendments,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to regulate the catching of fish in the waters of Wye and Miles Rivers, and to regulate the taking of terrapins in said rivers, and the Choptank River, in Talbot County,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
