Leave was granted to the Committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries to introduce a bill to be entitled an Act to repeal Chapter 150, of the Acts passed at Session of 1874, to establish a Commission of Fisheries, and amend and re-enact the same.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 30, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Rehypothecation,"

Was read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follows:
