Said bill was then returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Bannon, from a Select Committee, (by unanimous consent,) reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the building of a school-house for colored children in the Fourth District, and one in the First District of Anne Arundel County.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Dennis, from a Select Committee, (by unanimous consent,) reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to prohibit the taking or catching of oysters with scoops, drags, rakes or dredges or such like instruments, in certain waters of Somerset County.

Which was read the first time.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates appeared, and delivered

House bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 19, of Article 21, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Washington County," sub-title "Almshouse," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators Newcomer, Bannon and Wilson.

Also, delivered

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Cecil County to revise and correct the valuation of the lands of said county assessed to James R. Green, and to refund to said Green any taxes that he may have paid by reason of over valuation of said lands, &c.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.
