Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Somerset County to have a bridge built across the Annamessex River,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

House bill entitled an Act to more effectually protect travellers against the payment of illegal tolls, which may be charged by any of the several Turnpike Companies chartered under the Act of 1804, Chapter 51, or any supplement thereto.
