Mr. Sulivane submitted the following amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Strike out all after "A bill entitled" and insert in lieu thereof the following: "An Act to create a new election district in Caroline County, to be known as "Ridgely District," or "District No. 6," of Caroline County.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new election district be formed and laid out of portions of the Second and Third Election Districts of Caroline County, to be known as "Ridgely District" or "District No. 6," of Caroline County, whose metes and bounds shall be as follows: Beginning for the lines thereof at the mouth of Tuck-a-Hoe Creek, where it intersects Choptank river, then northerly with said river, and binding therewith to a place commonly called and known by the name of "Stock Landing" or "Brick Mill," thence with the county road that runs from said mill to Bridgetown, until it intersects or reaches the branch on the north side of the farm of James A. Roe, "Arable Land," then with said branch to the head
