Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal the following Acts of the General Assembly, relating to pensions; 1870, Chapter 477; 1872, Chapter 309; 1874, Chapter 305, 351 and 415; and 1876, Chapter 320,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Leave to the Committee on Finance to introduce a bill to be entitled an Act to repeal Chapter 439, of the Acts of January Session, 1874, relative to issuing licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in this State, so far as the same relates to Montgomery County,
