Also, unfavorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 14, of the Act entitled an Act to incorporate a company to build a turnpike road from Liberty town, Frederick County, through Johnsville to Pipe Creek, passed at the Session of 1864, Chapter 338.

Which was adopted.
