House bill entitled an Act to extend the jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace in Allegany and other counties, in petty criminal cases, by adding new sections to Article 1, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Allegany County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace," to be numbered 98 A, 98 B, 98 C, 98 D, 98 E, 98 F and 98 G.
