Which was read a first time, and referred to Messrs. Lancaster, Hill and Gorman.

House bill to authorize the Comptroller to pay John A. Gillam, of Allegany County, a sum of money.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

House bill to amend certain Sections of Article 4, Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore City," sub-title "Harbors."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Baltimore-City Senators.

House bill to authorize Commissioners of Baltimore County to settle claims of Augustus F. Dawes.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Freeman, Steiner and Humphreys.

House bill to empower Board of School Commissioners of Baltimore County to pay R. M. G. Trainer for services rendered as teacher.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators-Freeman, Steiner and Humphreys.

House bill to sanction bequest of John Beggs to the Trustees of the Benjamin's or Krider's Reformed Church, in Carroll County.
