Which was read the second time.

Mr. Gorman, from the Committee on Corporations, reported favorably,

House bill to repeal the Act of 1867, Chapter 216, entitled an Act to incorporate the Gwynn's Falls Bridge Company of the Washington Road.

Which was read the second time.

Also, unfavorably,

House bill entitled an Act to enable the Lake Chrome and Mineral Company of Baltimore County to make and enforce payments of all calls or assessments upon its capital stock,

Which was adopted.

Said bill was then returned to the House of Delegates.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to organize the Maryland and Delaware Railroad after sales under decrees for foreclosures, by that or some other name that may hereafter be adopted and to incorporate the same into a body politic.

Which was read the second time.

Also,

House bill to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to subscribe to the capital stock of the Maryland and Delaware Ship Canal Company, or to endorse the bonds of said Company,

Being upon its second reading,

On motion by Mr. Gorman,

Said bill was referred to the Baltimore City Senators.

Mr. Gorman, from the Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill to authorize the Commissioners of Howard County, to issue bonds to raise money to build a new jail in Howard County.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Bannon, from the Committee on Public Buildings, submitted

The testimony of the Committee in relation to the investi-
