

The Clerk of the House of Delegates appeared and delivered the following bills:

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Sections 173 of Article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled "Crimes and Punishments" sub-title "Rogues and Vagabonds" and reenact the same with amendments.

Endorsed: "Passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendments:"

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 2, after the word "Implement," insert "at places and under circumstances from which an intent may be presumed," striking out the words "with an intent."

Section 6, strike out the word "with" and insert "also at places and under circumstances from which may be presumed an."

Strike out in the last line "eighteen months," and insert "one," and add after the word years, "or by imprisonment in jail at the discretion of the court for a like term."
