Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the 19th Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Somerset County," sub-title "Princess Anne," as amended by Chapter 183, of the Acts of 1867, by repealing Sections 108 and 109 of Chapter 183, of the Acts of 1867, entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Princess Anne, in Somerset County, Maryland, and re-enacting the same with amendments, and to add a new section thereto.

Endorsed: Reported unfavorably from Select Committee, and the report adopted.

Senate bill entitled an Act to prevent the disclosure of condidential communications made by patients to physicians and surgeons.

Endorsed: Considered, amended and laid upon the table.

Senate bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 53, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Landlord and Tenant," sub-title "Distress for Rent," for the better protection of tenants.

Endorsed: Reported unfavorably from the Committee on the Judiciary, and the report adopted.
