AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Add to Section 2, *Provided*, also that the waters of Chop-tank River, lying north of a straight line running from Benoni's Point to Clara's Point, are hereby reserved for tongmen, and it shall not be lawful to catch oysters with scoop, scrape, or similar instrument to the northward of said line.
