House bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 54, of Article 16, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," relating to the annual salary of the Clerk to the County Commissioners and re-enact the same with amendments,

With the following amendment:
