they mature, the County Commissioners of Calvert County shall include in the levy for the year after their issuance and each year thereafter until they mature and have been redeemed, an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on the bonds and to redeem them as they mature.

SEC. 9. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 566.

(Senate Bill 365)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 299 and 299A of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Calvert County", sub-title "State's Attorney", Section 299 having been amended by Chapter 298 of 1933 and Section 299A having been enacted by Chapter 727 of 1943, relating to the compensation of the State's Attorney of Calvert County.

Whereas, Chapter 791 of the Acts of 1945 prescribes the salaries for the State's Attorneys of the several Counties, thereby making the above sections unnecessary; therefore

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 299 and 299A of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Calvert County", sub-title "State's Attorney", Section 299 having been amended by Chapter 298 of 1933 and Section 299A having been amended by Chapter 727 of 1943, be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.
