CHAPTER 656.

(Senate Bill 394)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 731 and 732 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County", sub-title "State's Attorney, relating to the compensation of the State's Attorney of Frederick County.

WHEREAS, Chapter 791 of the Acts of 1945 prescribes the salaries of the State's Attorneys of the several Counties, thereby making the above sections unnecessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 731 and 732 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County", sub-title "State's Attorney", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.
