such vacancy within thirty days after such vacancy shall have occurred.

- (T) That in making the appointment to fill any such vacancy in the Office of Commissioner, the remaining qualified Commissioners shall make such appointment by entering in the minute book of said Commission, the fact of their making such appointment and the same day notifying the person so appointed of his said appointment.
- (U) That the Fruitland Commission shall keep a record of all its Commissioners, which record shall state: (1) The full name of each Commissioner; (2) When he was appointed or elected; (3) When he qualified by taking the oath of office; (4) When he ceased to be such Commissioner and the reason therefor, whether by expiration of his office, death, resignation or otherwise.
- SEC. 11. And be it further enacted, that this Act is hereby declared to be a public act and may be used in evidence in all Courts of this State without proof thereof.
- SEC. 12. And be it further enacted, that all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- SEC. 13. And be it further enacted, that if any part of this Act shall be held unconstitutional, or invalid or unenforceable, the same shall not affect the remaining part of this Act.
- SEC. 14. And be it further enacted, that this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 663.

(Senate Bill 415)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 68 of Article 35 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Evidence," subtitle "Proof of Accounts," relating to the admissibility in evidence of photographic and photostatic reproductions of certain documents.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 68 of Article 35 of the Annotated Code of
