of said notes and/or bonds shall mature and be redeemed. The taxes so levied shall be collected in the same manner as other taxes are levied and collected in said town.

Sec. 4. And be it further enacted, That the Town Commissioners of La Plata be and is hereby authorized and empowered to do all acts and things necessary to issue and sell said bonds, to have the same registered if necessary, and to issue negotiable promissory notes, and to do all things necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act, even though the same may not be specifically mentioned herein or in the Charter of the Town of La Plata or in any other Act relating to said town.

Sec. 5. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 883.

(House Bill 880)

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1943 Supplement), title "Crimes and Punishments", sub-title "Sabbath Breaking", said new section to be known as Section 576AA and to follow immediately after Section 576A of said Article, to authorize the operation of bowling alleys, tenpin alleys, or duckpin alleys, within the boundaries of Carroll County between the hours of 1 P. M. and 6 P. M. on Sunday, to repeal all public general laws and public local laws inconsistent herewith to the extent of any such inconsistency and to provide for a referendum thereon.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1943 Supplement), title "Crimes and Punishments", sub-title "Sabbath Breaking", said new section to be known as Section 576AA, to follow immediately after Section 576A of said Article, and to read as follows:

576AA. Nothing contained in Sections 560 or 576 of this Article shall be construed to prohibit or make unlawful the operation within the boundaries of Carroll County of any
