

repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

2. The Upper Potomac River Commission is hereby created and authorized to exercise, for the purposes herein set forth, all powers herein delegated to it. The word "Commission" as used herein is defined to mean the Upper Potomac River Commission. The District, for the purposes herein set forth, and for no other purposes, shall be under the jurisdiction of the Commission.

The Commission shall be composed of three members; one shall be appointed by the County Commissioners of Garrett County and one by the County Commissioners of Allegany County, and the third shall be named by the Governor of Maryland, the first appointments hereunder to be made on or before May 1, 1935, upon which date the terms of office shall begin. All appointees shall be residents and taxpayers of Allegany and Garrett Counties and shall serve for six years, or until their successors are appointed and have qualified, except that the first members appointed by the County Commissioners of Garrett County and Allegany County shall serve for terms of two and four years, respectively, and their successors for six years, so that the terms of one member of the Commission shall expire biennially. Upon the expiration of the terms of the members of said Commission, their successors shall be named in the same manner as the original appointments were made, except that each appointment shall be for a term of six years. Any vacancy occurring at any time in the personnel of the Commission shall be filled for the unexpired term by the agency making the original appointment. All members shall serve without compensation but they shall be allowed any reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their duties under this Act. The Governor shall designate the Chairman of the Commission. In the event that either or both Boards of County Commissioners shall fail or neglect to appoint a member of the Upper Potomac River Commission, as hereinbefore provided, then the Governor shall make such appointment or appointments for the full term or terms of such member or members. The Commission shall appoint, discharge at pleasure, and fix the compensation of such engineering, legal, clerical and other force and help as, from time to time, in its judgment may be deemed necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act. The Commission for the convenience of the citizens of said District may establish an office at a convenient place in the District. The Commission shall annually pub-
