CHAPTER 179.

(Senate Bill 239)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 444 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County", sub-title "Preston", increasing the debt limit to ten thousand dollars.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 444 of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Caroline County", sub-title "Preston", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

444. Said Commissioners may, whenever they deem it necessary, to borrow money on the credit of said town, by note or otherwise any amount they may deem necessary, provided that said indebtedness, thus created, shall not exceed at any time the sum of ten thousand (\$10,000) dollars.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.
