Library Committee of the Court of Appeals and the State Library.

WHEREAS, Section 122 of Article 41 provides for the appointment of a custodian of works of reference by the Governor at an annual salary of \$720 per year; and

WHEREAS, no provision is made in the present State Budget for such position; and

WHEREAS, the Library Committee of the Court of Appeals and the State Library has the responsibility of purchasing books and supervising the State Library; therefore

- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 121 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments", sub-title "State Librarian", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
 - 121. The library committee created by Section 117 of this Article, is authorized and empowered to appoint a person as Law Librarian of the State Library and such other employees as may be deemed necessary and at such compensation as shall be provided in the State Budget. It shall be the duty of the said Law Librarian and other employees to perform such services as shall be required of them by the said library committee.
 - SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That Section 122 of said Article be and it is hereby repealed.
 - SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 32.

(Senate Bill 83)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 7 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Health", sub-title "State Board of Health", relating to the compensation of Deputy Health Officers.
