notes or other evidence of indebtedness issued under authority of this section and the interest thereon must be paid by the Mayor and Council from the general taxes levied for the use of the city under the power conferred by its Charter, the levying or collecting of any special tax for the payment of such notes or other evidence of indebtedness being expressly prohibited.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly of Maryland, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 248.

## (House Bill 296)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 299 and 300 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Wicomico County", sub-title "Salisbury", said sections providing for yearly census of male persons, over age of twenty-one, living within the corporate limits of Salisbury.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 299 and 300 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Wicomico County", sub-title "Salisbury", be and they are hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.
