CHAPTER 274.

(House Bill 491)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 367 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Somerset County", sub-title "Revenue and Taxes", relating to the office hours of the Treasurer of Somerset County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 367 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Somerset County", sub-title "Revenue and Taxes", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

367. The County Commissioners shall appoint and furnish the Treasurer an office in the Courthouse for transaction of his official business which office shall be the County Commissioner's office, and the said office shall be open for that purpose each day of the year, Sunday and legal holidays excepted, from 8 o'clock A. M. to 5 P. M., except on Saturdays, when said office shall be open from 8 A. M. to 12 o'clock noon.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 275.

(House Bill 493)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 216(a) of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County", subtitle "Frederick City", sub-heading "City Register", as said section was amended by Chapter 618 of the Acts of 1943, increasing the compensation of the City Register of Frederick City.
