CHAPTER 7.

(Senate Bill 90)

- AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 102 and 103 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments", sub-title "Department of Legislative Reference", relating to the compensation of the Director and employees of the Department and reports to be submitted to said Department.
- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 102 and 103 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments", sub-title "Department of Legislative Reference, be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
- 102. The Director and employees of the Department of Legislative Reference shall receive such compensation as shall be provided in the State Budget and the operating expenses of the Department shall be as provided in said Budget.
- 103. It shall be the duty of every officer, board, institution and commission of the State, including special or temporary officers, boards and commissions, to file with the Department of Legislative Reference two copies of every regular or special report issued by him or it, whether such report be in printed or other form.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.
