and as the same may become due, the County Commissioners of Prince George's County are hereby authorized and directed to levy in each and every year upon the taxable basis of said Prince George's County, a tax sufficient to pay the bonds maturing during such year in accordance with the provisions thereof, and to pay interest on all of the bonds authorized by this Act, which may be outstanding and unredeemed in such year.

- Sec. 4. And be it further enacted, That the Board of County Commissioners of Prince George's County shall use the money received from the sale of said bonds, or any part thereof, issued hereunder for the purpose of constructing and equipping one or more additions to said Hospital or the Nurses Home and to construct and equip a Health Center, or more clinics, a building or buildings for the Health Department, a Nurses Training School or other buildings deemed necessary for the health of the people of Prince George's County, all such improvements to be made on land adjacent to said Hospital.
- SEC. 5. And be it further enacted, That the Board of County Commissioners of Prince George's County is hereby given full power and authority to regulate the use of any or all of said buildings and to do all things necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Act and Chapter 918 of the Acts of 1941.
- Sec. 6. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 430.

(House Bill 661)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 1 of Chapter 918 of the Acts of 1941, to change the classification of a hospital to be operated by the Board of County Commissioners of Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 1 of Chapter 918 of the Acts of 1941, be, and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
