

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Sections 507 and 508 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition) have long been obsolete because Mt. Washington is now within the limits of Baltimore City; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 507 and 508 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Baltimore County", sub-title "Mt. Washington", be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 444.

(House Bill 689)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 134 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Talbot County", sub-title "Easton", relating to the boundary lines of the wards in the Town of Easton.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 134 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Talbot County", sub-title "Easton", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

134. Easton shall be divided into four wards, bounded as follows: First Ward shall be bounded on the North and West by the boundaries of the town, and on the East by a line running Southwardly with the center-line of Aurora Street to the center of Goldsborough Street; thence Westwardly to the intersection of the center-line of Goldsborough Street with the center-line of Hanson Street; thence Southwardly with the center line of Hanson Street to its intersection with the center line of Brookletts Avenue; thence Westwardly with the center line of Brookletts Avenue to its intersection with the center line of Washington Street; thence Northwardly with the center line of Washington Street to its intersection with the center line of Biery Street; thence Westwardly with the center line of Biery Street if projected
