SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That* Section 509 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Talbot County", sub-title "State's Attorney", as said section was amended by Chapter 77 of the Acts of 1933, be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That* this Act shall take effect June 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 453.

(Hous eBill 714)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 233A of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County", sub-title "Fire Companies", as said section was amended by Chapter 453 of the Acts of 1945, providing appropriations for certain payments to the Stevensville Volunteer Fire Department, Inc.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That* Section 233A of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County", sub-title "Fire Companies", as said section was amended by Chapter 453 of the Acts of 1945, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

233A. The County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County are hereby authorized and directed to appropriate annually the sum of Fifty-five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500) for the use and benefit of the organized fire companies of Queen Anne's County and to levy on the taxable basis of said county a tax sufficient to produce said Fifty-five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500). The amount thus levied and appropriated shall be used for the purchase, improvement, maintenance and operation of fire apparatus and fire equipment for the said fire companies and the said Commissioners shall, on or before the fifteenth day of
