

Henryton Sanatorium Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), aggregating Two Hundred and Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$270,000.00), of which One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be from the issue of August 15, 1937, One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) from the issue of February 15, 1938, and Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) from the issue of August 15, 1938.

(14) To the State Tobacco Warehouse for repairs, alterations and improvements to warehouse building One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$115,000.00), of which Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) shall be from the issue of August 15, 1937, and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be from the issue of February 15, 1938.

(15) To the Conservation Commission for the construction and equipment of an addition to the Marine Laboratory at Solomons Island Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), all from the issue of February 15, 1938.
