

CHAPTER 500.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington County", sub-title "Clearspring", said new section to be known as Section 126A, and to follow immediately after Section 126 of said Article, to authorize the Commissioners of Clearspring to regulate parking within said town.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Washington County", sub-title "Clearspring", said new section to be known as Section 126A, to follow immediately after Section 126 of said Article, and to read as follows:

126A. The said Commissioners shall have power to pass ordinances to regulate the parking of vehicles on the public streets within the limits of said town.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1937.

CHAPTER 501.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 170 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1935 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "State Tax Commission", by fixing the scale of annual salaries of Supervisors of Assessments of Baltimore City and of the several Counties of the State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 170 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1935 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "State Tax Commission", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

170. The annual salaries of the Supervisors of Assessments shall be based on the aggregate value of property assessed for taxation in the County or City for which such supervisor is appointed and said salaries shall be as follows:

If the aggregate value shall not exceed \$5,000,000, the annual salary shall be \$750.
