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#### CHAPTER 85.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 458 of Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Harford County", sub-title "State's Attorney", as said section was amended by Chapter 20 of the Acts of 1933, providing for an increase in the salary now paid the State's Attorney.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 458 of Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Harford County", sub-title "State's Attorney", as said section was amended by Chapter 20 of the Acts of 1933, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

458. The State's Attorney of Harford County shall receive an annual salary of Twenty-five Hundred (\$2,500) Dollars, to be paid him by the County Commissioners of said County, in quarterly installments from the first Monday in January, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, the same to be levied by the County Commissioners for the use of the State's Attorney as aforesaid.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1937.

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#### CHAPTER 86.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 194 of Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Harford County", sub-title "Court Stenographer", as said section was amended by Chapter 19 of the Acts of 1933, providing for an increase in the salary of the Court Stenographer.
