words: "For Constitutional Amendment" and "Against Constitutional Amendment", as now provided by law, and immediately after said election due returns shall be made to the Governor of the vote for and against proposed amendment, as directed by said Fourteenth Article of the Constitution, and further proceedings had in accordance with said Article 14.

CHAPTER 526.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Baltimore City", sub-title "Special Fund", said new section to be known as Section 780, and to follow immediately after Section 779 of said Article, to provide for the refund of contributions to the Special Fund under certain conditions.

CHAPTER 527.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-sections (c), (d) and (e) of Section 3 of Article 95A, title "Unemployment Compensation", sub-title "Benefits"; to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (e) of Section 4 of Article 95A, title "Unemployment Compensation", sub-title "Benefit Eligibility Conditions"; to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (c) of Section 7 of Article 95A, title "Unemployment Compensation", sub-title "Contributions", sub-title "Records of Employer"; to repeal and re-enact with amendments, Sub-sections (q) and (s) of Section 19 of Article 95A, title "Unemployment Compensation", sub-title "Definitions", sub-title "Weekly Benefit Amount", so as to change the method of determining full time weekly wage in relation to benefit determination and payments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-sections (c), (d) and (e) of Section 3 of Article 95A, title "Unemployment Compensation", sub-title "Benefits", be, and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(c) Weekly Benefit for Partial Unemployment. Each eligible individual who is partially unemployed (as defined
