several counties of this State and in the City of Baltimore, under the sanction of said Convention, and to appoint, in its discretion, executive committees or other trustees, by whatever name or names they may be designated, for administering the respective funds so arising as aforesaid, in such manner and form and with such authority as the said Convention may from time to time prescribe.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1937.
