vision as to material and workmanship such work may be done.

- Sec. 5. And be it further enacted, That the proceeds from the sale of bonds aforesaid and the proceeds from subscriptions as hereinbefore provided shall be paid to the County Treasurer of Charles County, and shall be applied to the erection, equipment and furnishing of a Hospital for Charles County and such other expenses as the said Board have properly incurred in the discharge of its duty, and no part of the proceeds of the said bonds shall be paid out by the said Treasurer except upon the warrant of the said Board.
- Sec. 6. And be it further enacted, That the County Commissioners shall allocate annually from its share of the funds received from the licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages in Charles County, a sum sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds and to retire the One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of the principal becoming due each year. If, in any year, the sum received from the licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages is insufficient to pay said interest and to retire said principal, the said County Commissioners shall, for such year, levy upon the assessable property of Charles County a sufficient sum to make up such deficiency.
- Sec. 7. And be it further enacted, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
